Who is Jesus? Jesus is the Messiah... The suffering Messiah... Who calls us to follow Him.

"But what is this "self-denial" or "death to self," which goes hand in hand with restoration of the soul and eventually the whole person? At first it sound like some dreadfully negative thing that aims to annihilate us. And frankly, from the point of view of the ruined soul, self-denial is and will always be every bit as brutal as it seems to most people on first approach. The ruined life is not to be enhanced but replaced. We must simply *lose* our lives - that *ruined* life about which most people complain so much anyway."
