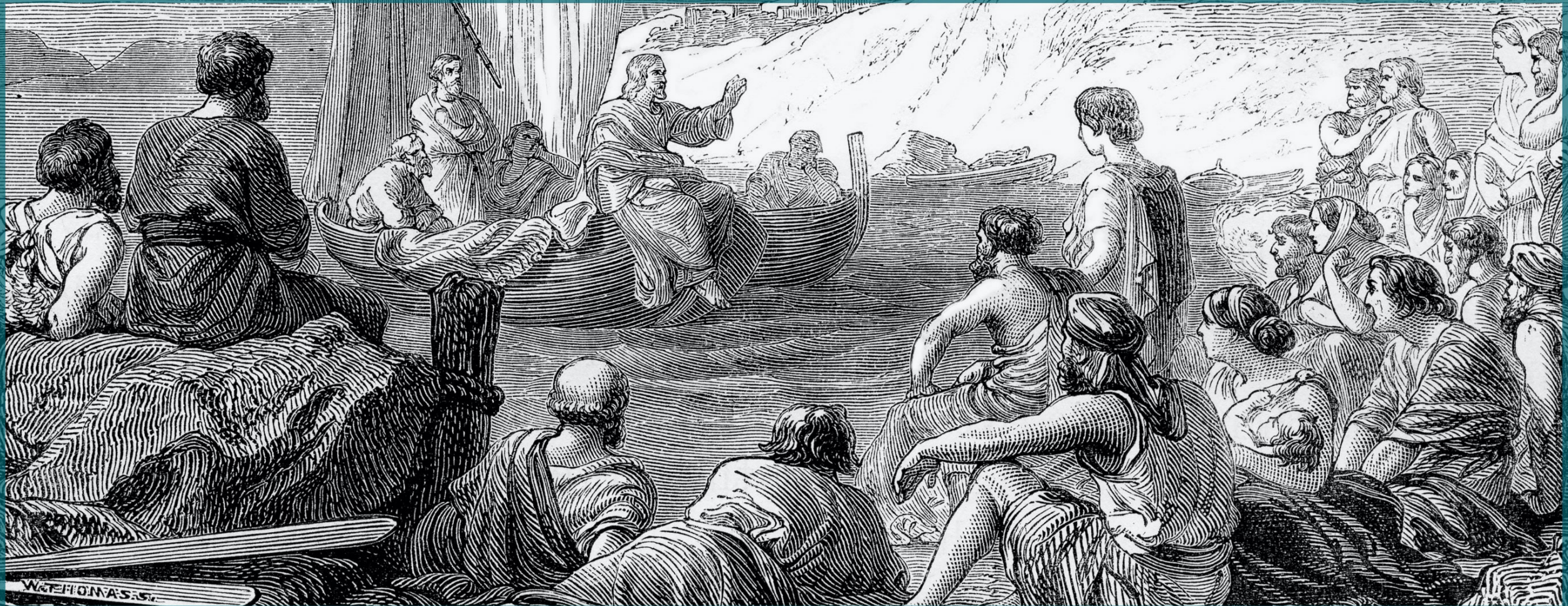

Big Idea:

The glory of Christ is accomplished through His suffering.

Mt. Tabor: 1,886 ft. above sea level

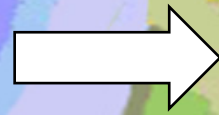
