



What is revival?



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- passively walked away from God,
- or actively rejected His purposes,

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Baby Boomers: Personal peace and affluence

Millennials: Personal pleasure and appeasement

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They end up being dead-end roads of....

- 1. Most revivals were preceded by a time of deep spiritual decline and despair. (2 Chronicles 29-31 King Hezekiah / Molech)
- 2. Each of these revivals began in the heart of one of God's servants, who then became the instrument in God's hands to stir up the sleeping consciences of God's people.
- 3. Every revival in the Old Testament rested solidly on a new and powerful proclamation of the Word of God.
- 4. Each revival was marked by a return to the genuine worship of God.
- 5. Revival resulted in a destruction of every idol that blocked the rightful acknowledgement of God as the only true and living God.

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9 characteristics of revival in the Old Testament

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California Assembly Bill 2223

The part of the bill that is generating the most concern is Section 7(a) which reads:

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- 6. There was a deep sense of sin and an overpowering desire to separate themselves from it and from all its sponsoring causes.
- Every revival in the Old Testament there was likewise a return to the offering of blood sacrifices.
- 8. Old Testament revivals resulted in the experience of a new sense of unbounded joy and exuberant gladness.

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
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
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- 5. Sleepy Christians wake up to the immediate sense of God's love and presence

- 7. There is always an excessive fringe of revival

- 9. Sometimes conservative, traditional church leaders become uncomfortable
- 10. There is usually a significant and real impact on society

When might a revival be expected?

When sincere Christians...

get involved

in seeking the welfare of their community and of the people in their circles of influence.

When might a revival be expected?

When sincere Christians...

have a heart to share the undying hope that they have graciously been given by Christ through His sacrificial love.

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I think it would be more likely that there could be regional revivals around the country when conditions reach crisis levels.

There is an incredible need for Christians to examine their lives and to consider which things to step away from and which to stand against in a culture that is contributing to its confusion, destruction, and disaster.

Revival is the visitation of God

which brings to life Christians who have been sleeping and restores a deep sense of God's near presence and holiness. Thence springs a vivid sense of sin and a profound exercise of heart in repentance, praise, and love, with an evangelistic outflow.
