
The seven spirits and the Holy Spirit are one in the same, and in Isaiah 11:2 they are listed:


- 1. The Spirit of the wisdom

- 7. The Spirit of the fear of the Lord

















Revelation 1

- 95 AD (CE)- impacted by the persecution of Roman Emperor Domitian.










The culture in Ephesus was decidedly anti-Christian.

Ephesus was a world-class city of 250,000 people with an intensely charged multi-religious and immoral environment:

- Caesar worship...even to enter into the Agora (marketplace).
- 14 Temples for worship of various Greek and Roman gods and goddesses.
- Temple to the Greek goddess *Artemis* (Roman Diana)- goddess of the hunt, the wilderness, the moon, fertility, childbirth and of fertility.....hundreds of temple prostitutes, both male and female.
- Demon worship at the temple of Didymus.
