The culture in Smyrna was decidedly hostile to Christians.

- Developing city until the Persians under Cyrus the Great destroyed it in 545 BC.
- 'Resurrected' in 340 BC by the Greek military leader Alexander the Great... (folklore of from death to resurrection...from obsolete to dynamic)
- Came under Roman rule in 133 BC.

Smyrna was a thriving port city of 200,00 people in Roman times...

... one of the most important ports in the entire world...

...gateway to Europe directly east of Athens across the Aegean Sea.

- A beautiful Mediterranean climate known for having exclusive rights for the import and export
 of the tree resin we call *Myrrh*, which was famous for its fragrance and embalming
 properties...used throughout the Middle East and especially Egypt.
- Smyrna was one of the official sites of Emperor worship...
 in this case, the compulsory worship of *Domitian* under threat of death if you did not
 proclaim your loyalty to him as God once a year in the Agora...
 in effect it was more of a political loyalty than a religious loyalty.
- The "Golden Street"- anchored by temples to **Cybele** and **Zeus**.... ...Apollo and Aphrodite in between.

 --relates to any part of us that feels strong emotion, passion,
 "the capacity to feel suffering".

The Lord has privileged us to have great capacity for *feeling* (passion, emotion, affections). Indeed, this is inherent because all people are created in the divine image.

Note for example how Jesus in His perfect (sinless) humanity keenly felt.
