
In the books of Ezekiel, Daniel, Matthew and *Revelation* (and various others)


the culmination of human history is intentionally addressed in order to help believers understand what is going on and how to navigate the events of our day.





- Emperor worship remained compulsory throughout the Roman Empire, and therefore played a strong role in the lives of the citizens of Thyatira.
- Jews were the only group given an exemption from emperor worship due to their unalterable monotheistic worldview and tremendous value to the business world.




