- We can be so fickle in a world that seldom or never stays stable...
"Without faith in Jesus' resurrection the Christian faith too easily slips into a modish existentialism with Christian trappings." *Fredrick Bruner*
- The 'spirit' is willing but our 'flesh' is weak...
"On our own, we are much weaker than we think, even when we know our devotion is strong." *Frederick Bruner*
- God's faithfulness is easily ignored or dismissed when we trust in ourselves...
"Peter clearly preferred to live discipleship on the foundation of his dedication rather than on His (*Christ's*) forgiveness. In theology, this is perfectionism."
