




The Book of Common Prayer (BCP)

is a collection of liturgical texts used primarily in Anglican and Episcopal churches.

It provides a framework for worship, including daily prayers, sacraments, and other rites. The first Book of Common Prayer was published in 1549 in England and has been revised and adapted over time for various Anglican churches.
