## Colossians 2:8-19 (16-19)

- <sup>8</sup> See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ.
- <sup>9</sup> For in Him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily,
- <sup>10</sup> and you have been filled in Him, who is the head of all rule and authority.
- <sup>11</sup> In Him also you were circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ,
- <sup>12</sup> having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised with Him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised Him from the dead.
- <sup>13</sup> And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our trespasses,
- <sup>14</sup> by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This He set aside, nailing it to the cross.
- <sup>15</sup> He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in Him.



## **Colossians 2:8-19 (16-19)**

- <sup>16</sup> Therefore let no one pass judgment on you in questions of food and drink,  
or with regard to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath.
- <sup>17</sup> These are a shadow of the things to come,  
but the substance belongs to Christ.
- <sup>18</sup> Let no one disqualify you, insisting on asceticism and worship of angels, going on in detail about visions, puffed up without reason by his sensuous mind,
- <sup>19</sup> and not holding fast to the Head, from whom the whole body, nourished and knit together through its joints and ligaments, grows with a growth that is from God.

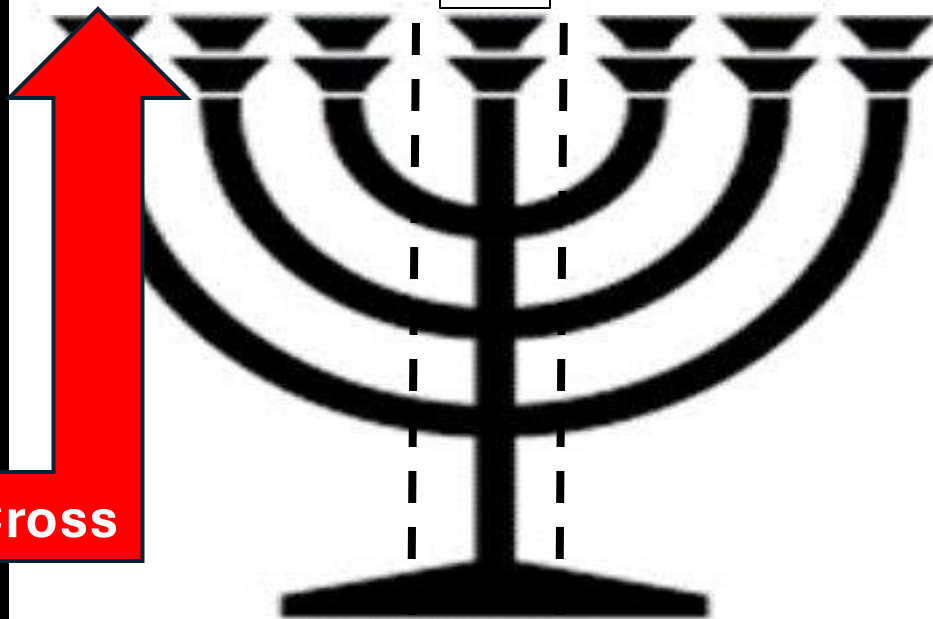

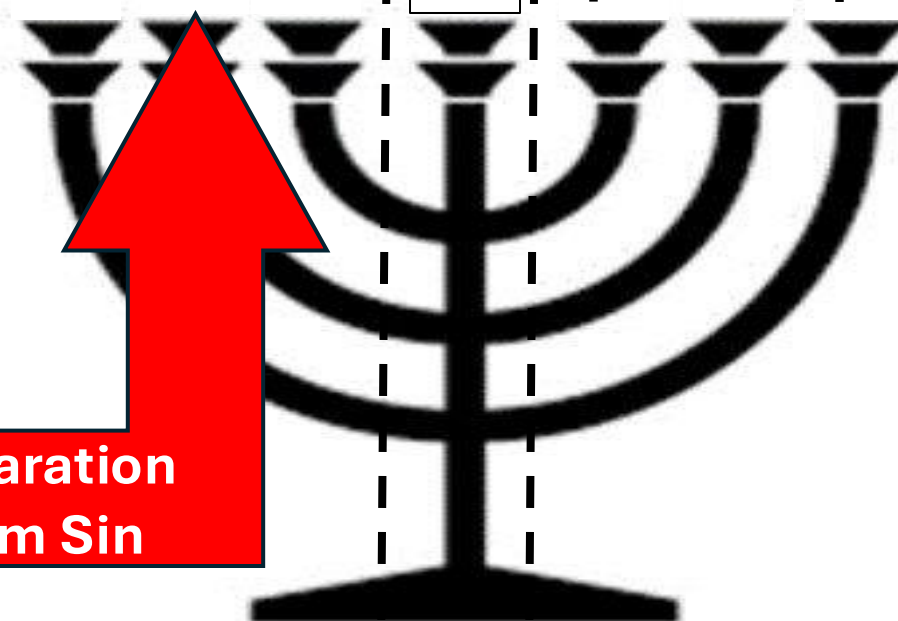

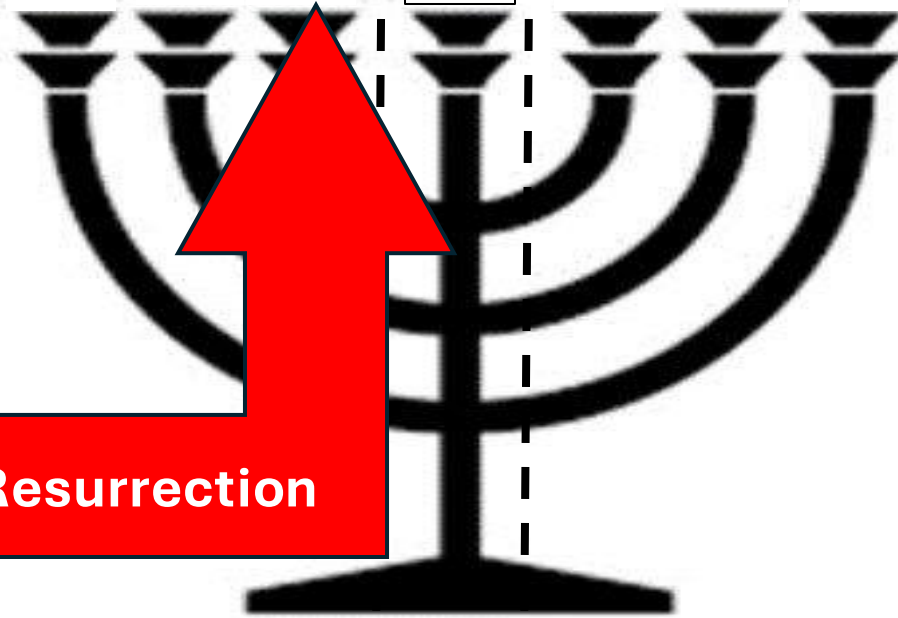

## **I Corinthians 11:23-26**

<sup>23</sup> For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when He was betrayed took bread,

<sup>24</sup> and when He had given thanks, He broke it, and said,

***“This is my body, which is for you.***

***Do this in remembrance of me.”***

<sup>25</sup> In the same way also He took the cup, after supper, saying,

***“This cup is the new covenant in my blood.***

***Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.”***

<sup>26</sup> For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.
