1:9 *(speaking of spiritual leadership)* **He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it.**

Titus 2

Affirmation of sound doctrine...

2:7-8 ...in your teaching show integrity, dignity, and sound speech that cannot be condemned, so that an opponent may be put to shame, having nothing evil to say about us.

Affirmation of sound doctrine...

2:9-10 Bondservants are to be submissive to their own masters in everything; they are to be well-pleasing, not argumentative, not pilfering, but showing all good faith, so that in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior.

1:16 *(speaking of false teachers)* They profess to know God, but they deny Him by their works. They are detestable, disobedient, unfit for any good work.

lawlessness and to purify for Himself a people for
His own possession who are zealous for good works.**

3:14 Let our people learn to devote themselves to good works, so as to help cases of urgent need, and not be unfruitful.
