

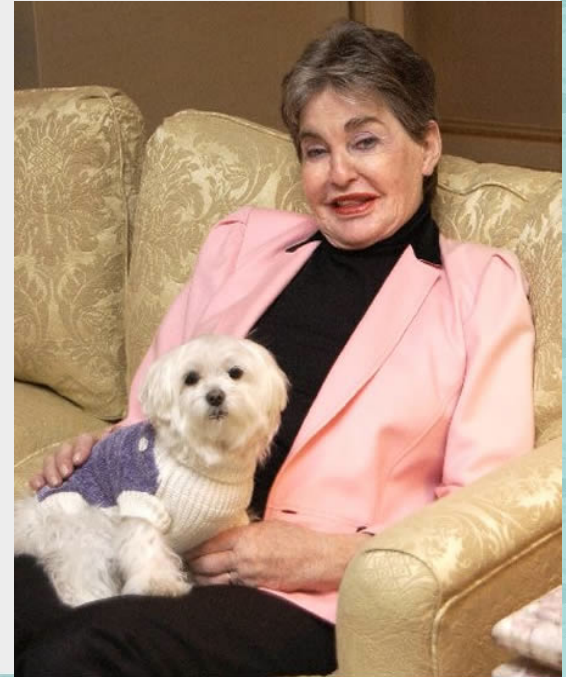

Luis Carlos de Noronha Cabral da Camara :
70 people listed in a Lisbon phone directory were contacted out of the blue after his death to be told he had made them his beneficiaries. They had been chosen at random from the directory, in front of two witnesses at a registry office 13 years before. It certainly came as a shock to them.



Stories of Inheritance

Nina Wang, who died of cancer in 2007 at age 69, signed over her fortune to a previously unknown feng shui master Tony Chan as a promise for eternal life. Wang changed her will in 2006 in order to leave everything to the feng shui master, voiding a previous will written four years earlier that left the fortune to her family and to charity. With no children of her own, Wang wrote a new will in 2006, two years after her ovarian cancer was diagnosed, making 48-year-old Chan her sole beneficiary.



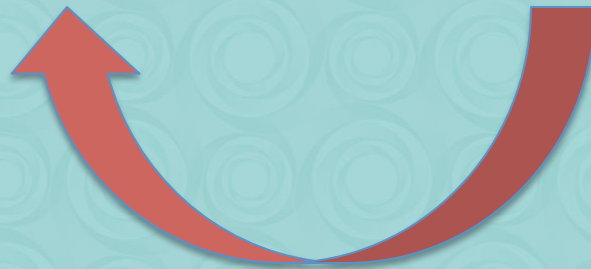

3:15-29

21 Is the law then contrary to the promises of God?

Certainly not!

For if a law had been given that could give life, then righteousness would indeed be by the law.

22 But the Scripture imprisoned everything under sin, so that the promise of faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.



3:15-29

- 23 Now before faith came, we were held captive under the law, imprisoned until the coming faith would be revealed.
- 24 So then, the law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith.
- 25 But now that faith has come,
we are no longer under a guardian,
- 26 for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God through faith.



3:15-29

- 27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.
- 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek,
there is neither slave nor free,
there is no male or female,
for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- 29 And if you are Christ's,
then you are Abraham's offspring,
heirs according to promise.

Romans 4:13-16



nothing you don't

- 13 For the promise to Abraham and his offspring that he would be heir of the world did not come through the law but through the righteousness of faith.
- 14 For if it is the adherents of the law who are to be the heirs, faith is null and the promise is void.
- 15 For the law brings wrath, but where there is not law there is no transgressions.
- 16 That is why it depends on faith, in order that ***the promise may rest on grace*** and be guaranteed to all his offspring—not only to the adherents of the law but also to the one who shares the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all.
