Genesis 12:1-3



- 1 Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you.
- 2 And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.
- 3 I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

Genesis 15:1-6



- After these things the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision: Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great.
- 2 But Abram said, "O Lord God, what will you give me, for I continue childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?"
- 3 And Abram said, "Behold, you have given me no offspring, and a member of my household will be my heir."
- 4 And behold, the word of the Lord came to him: "This man shall not be your heir".

Genesis 15:1-6



5 And He brought him outside and said,
"Look toward heaven, and number the stars,
if you are able to number them."

Then He said to him, "So shall your offspring be."

6 And he believed the Lord, and He counted it to him as righteousness.

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Genesis 15:7-10, 17-18



- 7 And He said to him, "I am the Lord who brought you out from Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land to possess."
- 8 But he said, "O Lord God, how am I to know that I shall possess it?"
 - 9 He said to him, "Bring me a heifer three years old, a female goat three years old, a ram three year od, a turtledove, and a young pigeon."
 - 10 And he brought Him all these, cut them in half, and laid each half over against the other. But he did not cut the birds in half.

Genesis 15:7-10, 17-18



- 17 When the sun had done down and it was dark, behold, a smoking fire pot and a flaming torch passed between these pieces.
- 18 On that day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying, "To your offspring I give this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates,
- 19 the land of the Kenites, the Kenizzites, the Kadmonites,
- 20 the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Rephaim, the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Girgashites and the Jebusites.

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- 7 Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham.
- And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying,
 - "In you shall all the nations be blessed."
- 9 So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.




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
