Epistemology: The theory of *knowledge*

Correspondence theory:

truth is that which corresponds with the way the world actually is.

Coherence theory:

truth are those things that cohere with our other justified beliefs.

Pragmatic theory:

truth is that which works for us and meets our needs better than the alternatives.

Divine (theistic) command theory:

truth is that which is grounded in the character and the creative/sustaining nature of God.
