When a person consciously and willfully rejects the operation of the Holy Spirit bearing witness to the reality of Jesus as the Savior and rejects the convicting power of the Spirit in his or her life.

Blasphemy of the Holy Spirit:

When a person consciously and willfully rejects the operation of the Holy Spirit bearing witness to the reality of Jesus as the Savior and rejects the convicting power of the Spirit in his or her life.

The person who does not receive this work of the Spirit cannot come to Jesus and therefore cannot receive forgiveness.
