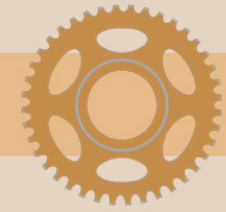

Prayer is our response to seeing the inadequacy of life without God in the picture.

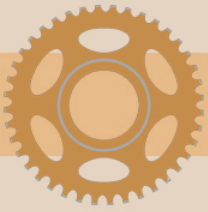
