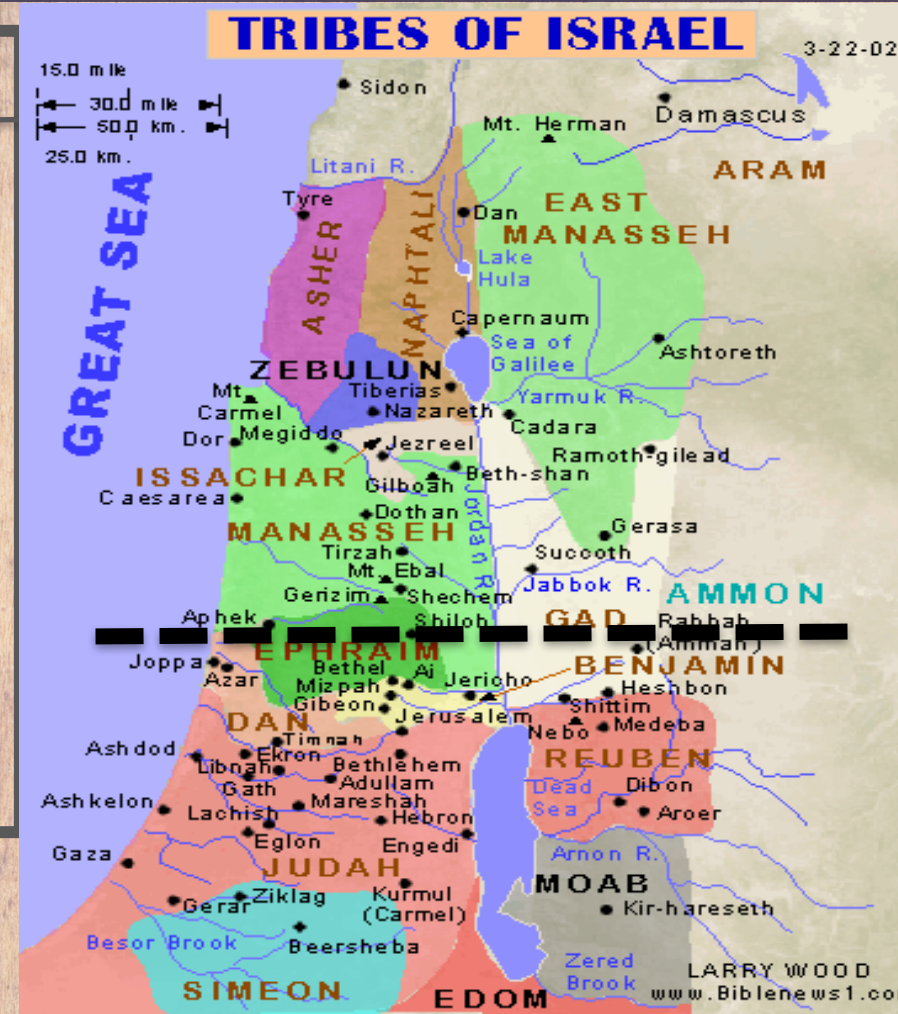

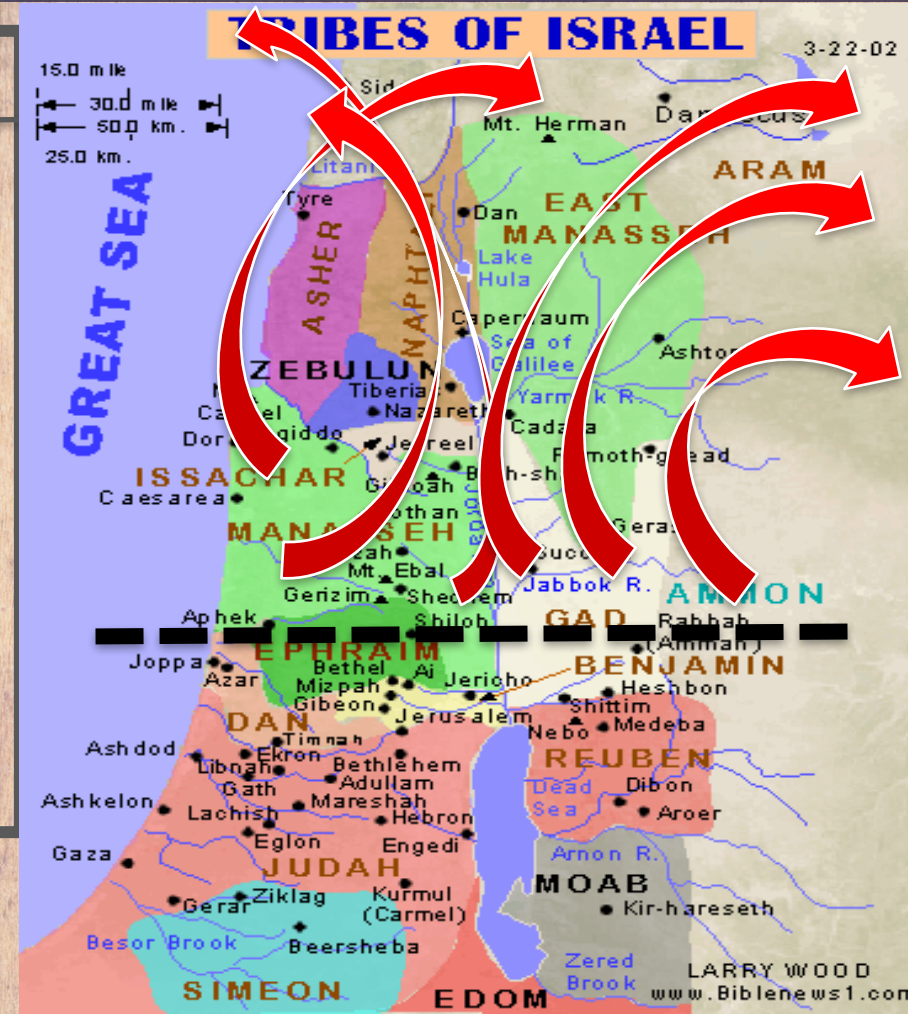

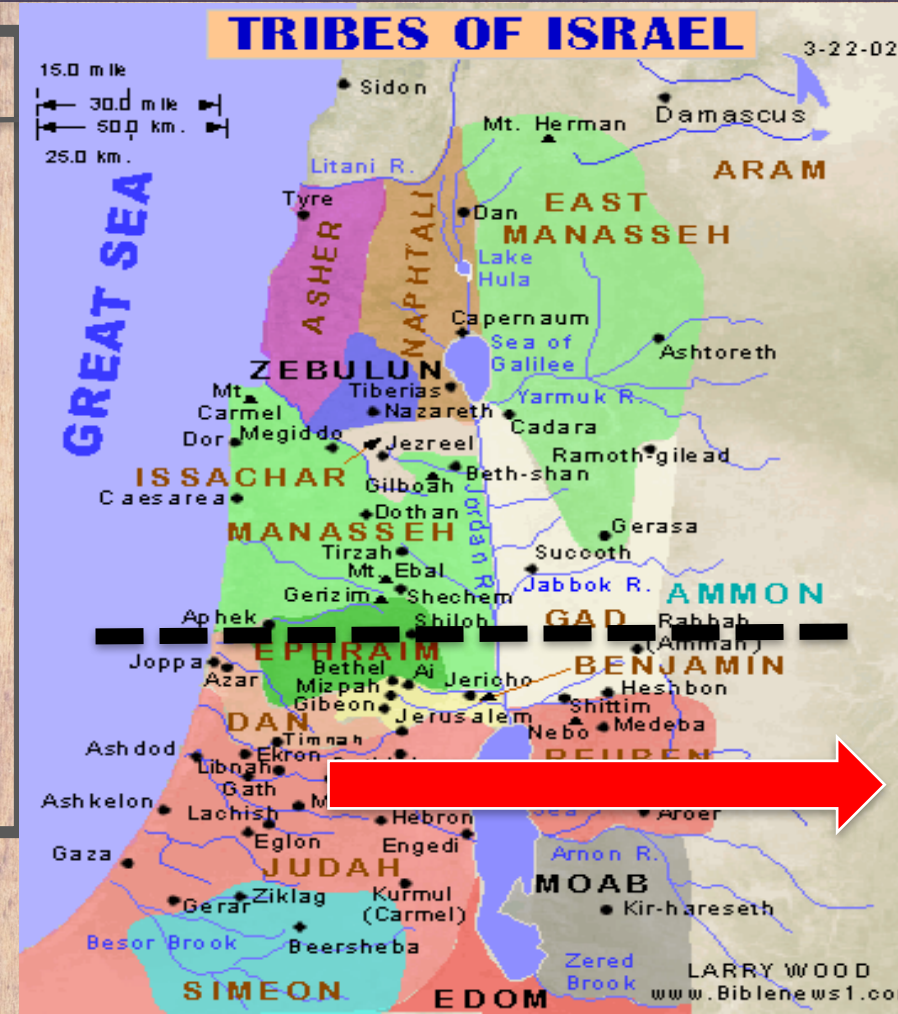

The Roman Empire c. 44 BCE





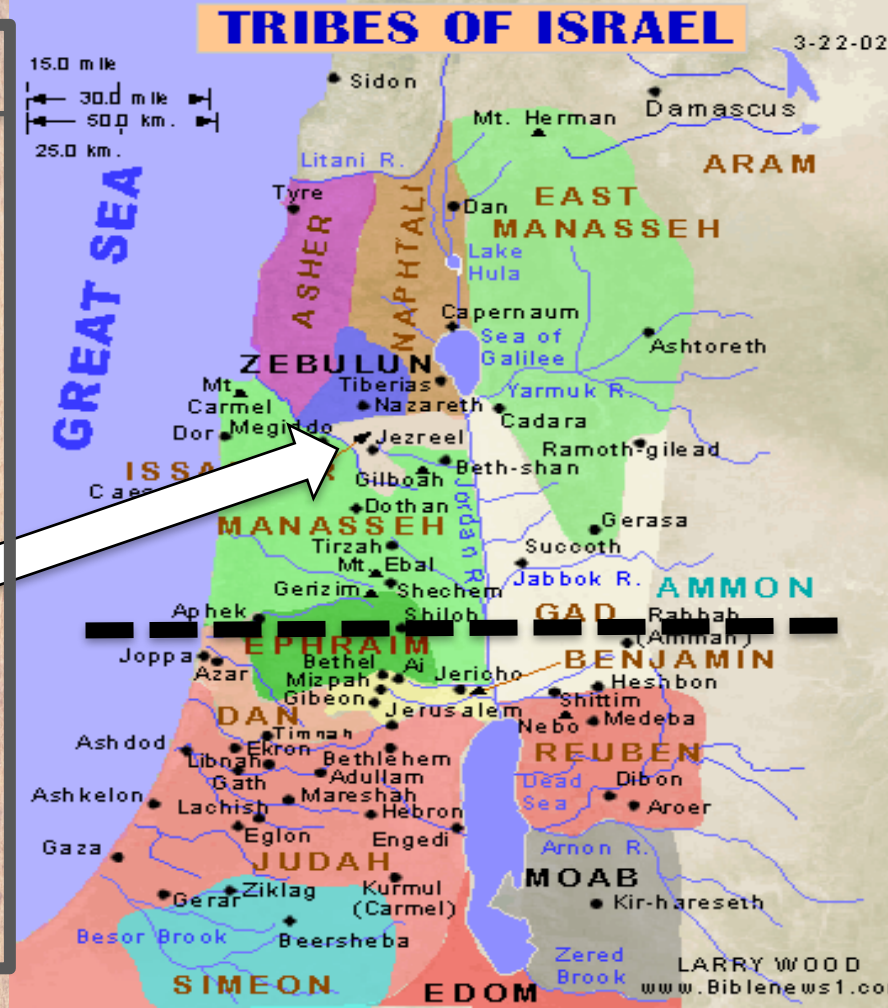
