Chapters 4-7

4:1-11

1 Hear the word of the LORD, O children of Israel, for the LORD has a controversy with the inhabitants of the land.

There is no faithfulness or steadfast love, and no knowledge of God in the land; there is swearing, lying, murder, stealing, and committing adultery; they break all bounds, and bloodshed follows bloodshed.

- Therefore the land mourns, and all who dwell in it languish, and also the beasts of the field and the birds of the heavens, and even the fish of the sea are taken away.
- 4 Yet let no one contend, and let none accuse, for with you is my contention, O priest.



Chapters 4-7

- 6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge; because you have rejected knowledge, I reject you from being a priest to me. And since you have forgotten the law of God, I also will forget your children.
- 7 The more they increased, the more they sinned against me;


I will change their glory into shame.

8 They feed on the sin of my people; they are greedy for their iniquity.



Chapters 4-7

- 9 And it shall be like people, like priest; I will punish them for their ways and repay them for their deeds.
- 10 They shall eat, but not be satisfied;
 they shall play the whore, but not multiply,
 because they have forsaken the LORD to cherish
- whoredom, wine, and new wine, which take away the understanding.





Chapters 4-7

6:1-17

- 1 "Come, let us return to the Lord; for He has torn us, that He may heal us; He has struck us down, and He will bind us up.
- 2 After two days He will revive us; on the third day He will raise us up, that we may live before Him.
- 3 Let us know; let us press on to know the LORD; His going out is sure as the dawn; He will come to us as the showers, as the spring rains that water the earth."



Chapters 4-7

- 4 What shall I do with you, O Ephraim?
 What shall I do with you, O Judah? Your love is like a morning cloud, like dew that goes early away.
- Therefore I have hewn them by the prophets;
 I have slain them by the words of my mouth,
 and my judgment goes forth as the light.
- 6 For I desire steadfast love and not sacrifice, the knowledge of God rather than burnt offerings.
- 7 But like Adam they transgressed the covenant; there they dealt faithlessly with Me.

Even in the midst of our decay and demise God is aimed at our restoration and transformation.

7:13-16

- 13 "Woe to them,
 for they have strayed from me!
 Destruction to them,
 for they have rebelled against me!
 I would redeem them,
 but they speak lies against me.

 14 They do not cry to me from the heart
- 14 They do not cry to me from the heart, but they wail upon their beds; for grain and wine they gash themselves; they rebel against me.

- 15 Although I trained and strengthened their arms, yet they devise evil against me.
- 16 They return, but not upward;
 they are like a treacherous bow;
 their princes shall fall by the sword because of the insolence of their tongue.

This shall be their derision in the land of Egypt.
