- 19 For they all seek their own interests, not those of Jesus Christ.



- 22 and trust in the Lord that shortly I myself will come also.


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
Timeline of Timothy's life




Tímeline of Timothy's life




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
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
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Stages of Development

- 7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

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




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One point perspective
