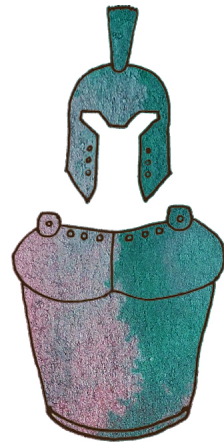
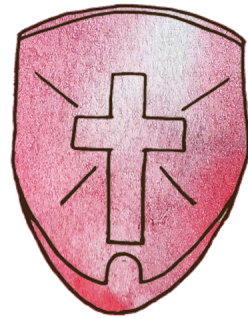

II Corinthians 2:5-11

⁵ Now if anyone has caused pain, he has caused it not to me, but in some measure— not to put it too severely— to all of you.

⁶ For such a one, this punishment by the majority is enough,

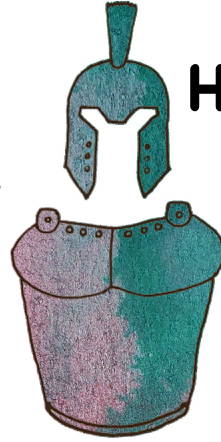

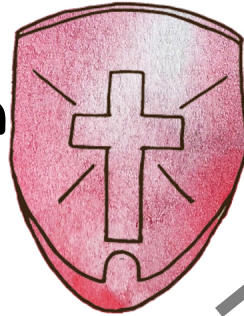

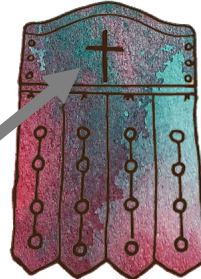
