My parents and I took a nice day trip along the coast from our home in Pacific Grove to Fort Ord, California. During World War I, this area was designated as an artillery training field by the Department of War. Now, only a year before, it officially became Fort Ord and expanded rapidly to prepare for the possibility of World War II coming across the ocean and drawing America into it.

We settled down amongst hundreds of soldiers and their families to watch a show sitting in an open-air theater with the Pacific Ocean as the backdrop. The Edgar Bergen and Charlie McCarthy Show normally heard on the radio every Sunday afternoon was entertaining us live! In addition to The Bergen McCarthy Show, Abbott and Castillo were there performing their routine. It was quite a thrill and great fun seeing these acts that I had only ever heard on the radio.



In the middle of the show the host came out and everything came to a standstill. We all held our breath. He begins by listing various regiments and battalions and announces,

"Will all the members of these regiments and battalions report to their barracks and prepare for overseas movement because the Japanese have attacked Pearl Harbor!"

As a collective gasp went up, across the theater, in the stands and on the lawn, soldiers everywhere stood up, kissed their families goodbye and headed out of the arena. We didn't leave immediately but shortly after that we went back to our home in Pacific Grove and that was my introduction to the second world war.

I was nine years old.
