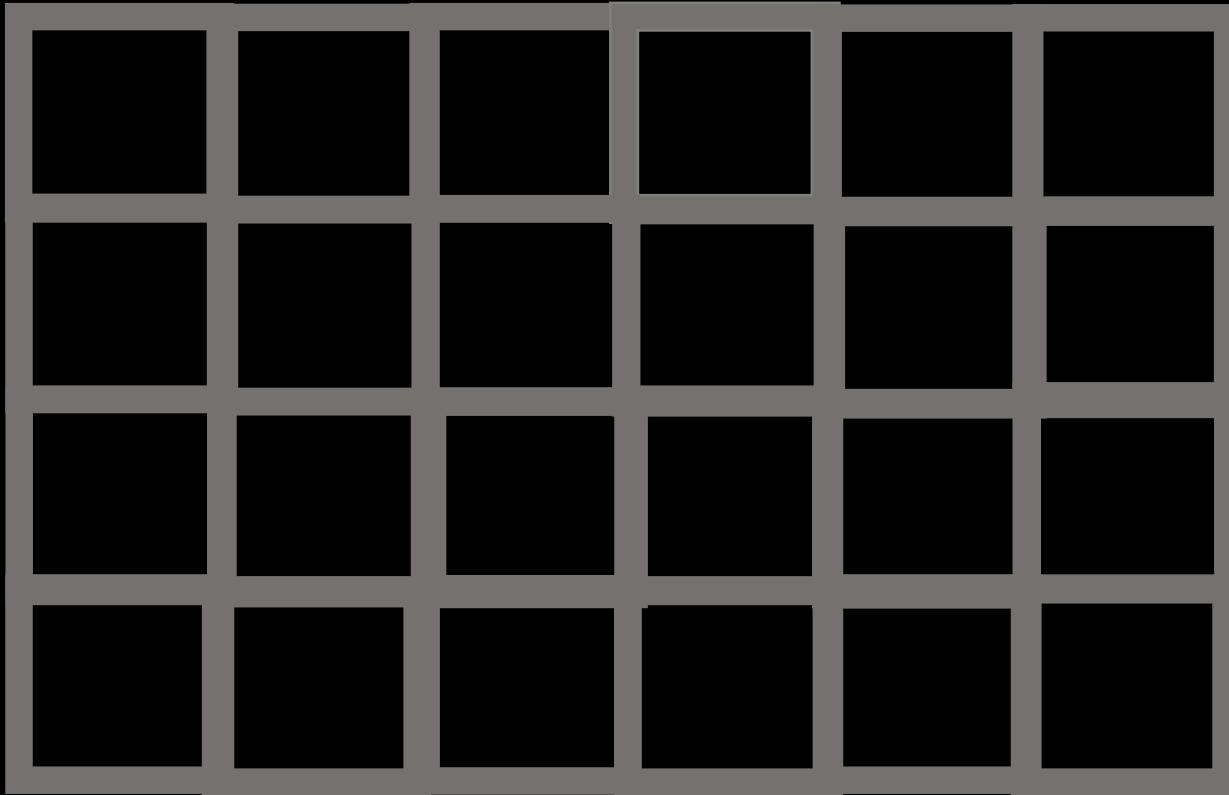

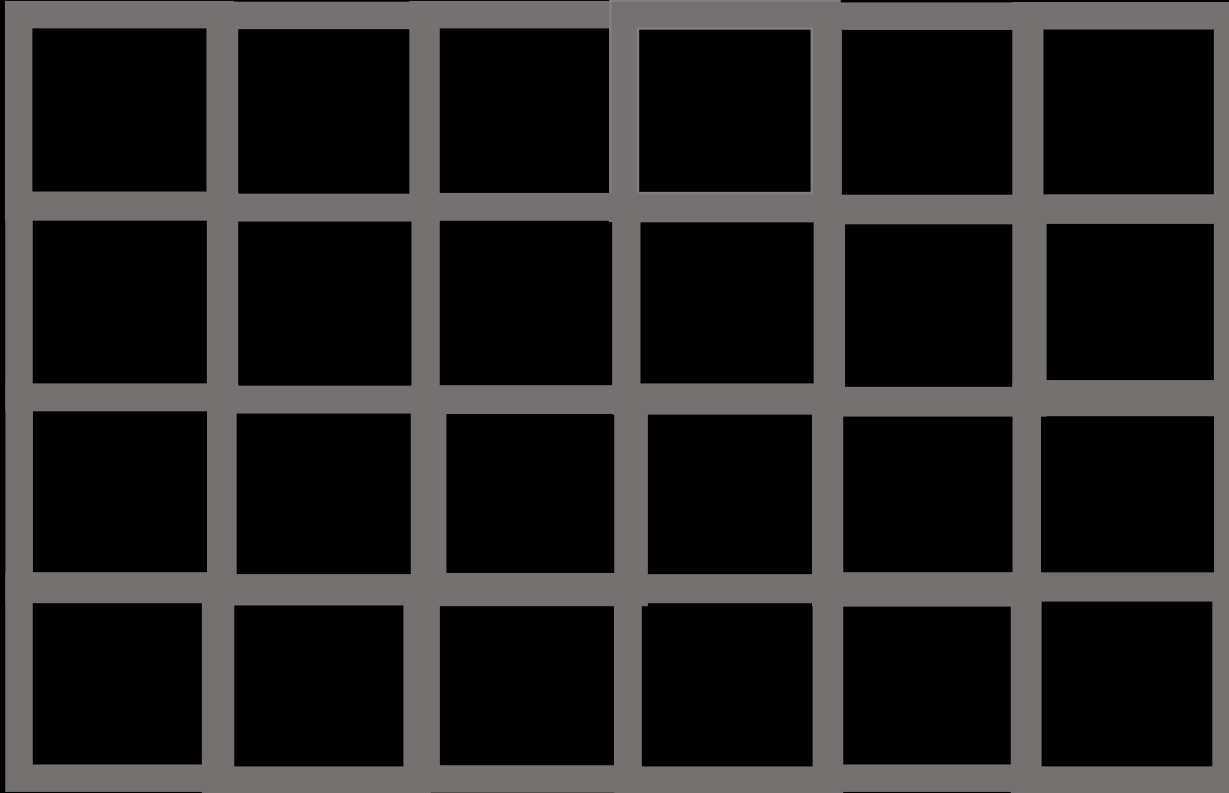

...the ***'weights'*** and the ***'sins'*** that ***'cling so closely'***.

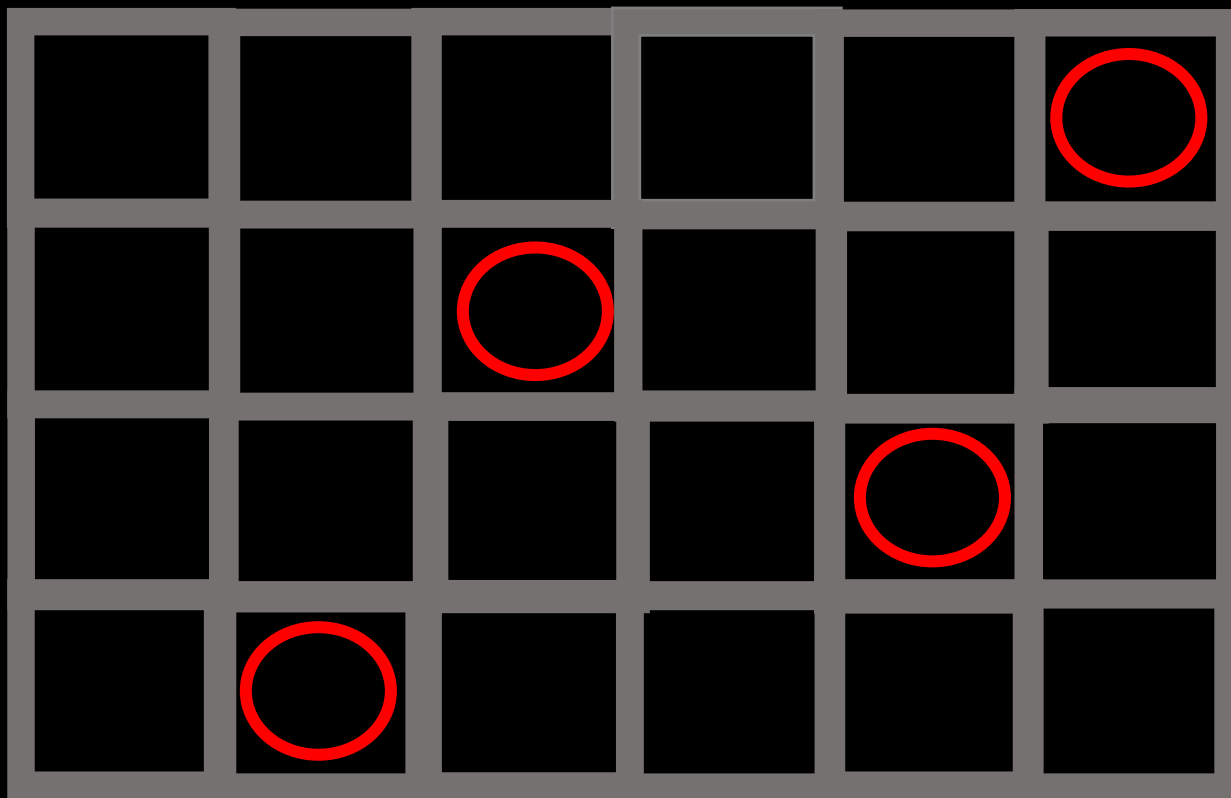
Weights: *What are you carrying that you shouldn't be carrying?*
