Ceremonial Law

Expressions or symbols of God's initiation and restoration; all fulfilled in Christ.

Judicial / Civil Law

Guidelines for justice in a theocracy that protects people; satisfied in the work of Christ.

Moral Law

Unconditional standards that form the eternal ethics of substance, for which Christ willing died so that we can obey from the Spirit rather than the flesh.

Ceremonial Law

Expressions or symbols of God's initiation and restoration; all fulfilled in Christ.

Judicial / Civil Law

Guidelines for justice in a theocracy that protects people; satisfied in the work of Christ.

Moral Law

Unconditional standards that form the eternal ethics of substance, for which Christ willing died so that we can obey from the Spirit rather than the flesh.
