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Ceremonial Law

Expressions or symbols of God's initiation and restoration; all fulfilled in Christ.

Judicial / Civil Law

Guidelines for justice in a theocracy that protects people; satisfied in the work of Christ.

Moral Law

Unconditional standards that form the eternal ethics of substance, for which Christ willingly died so that we can obey from the Spirit rather than the flesh.

Today's BIG IDEA

Simple and straightforward integrity and honesty reflect what God is like and paves the path for healthy and productive human relationships.

- 33 "Again you have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform to the Lord what you have sworn.'
- **34** But I say to you, Do not take an oath at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of God,
- **35** or by the earth, for it is his footstool, or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King.
- **36** And do not take an oath by your head, for you cannot make one hair white or black.
- **37** Let what you say be simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything more than this comes from evil.

Numbers 30:1-2

Moses spoke to the heads of the tribes of the people of Israel, saying, "This is what the LORD has commanded. If a man vows a vow to the LORD, or swears an oath to bind himself by a pledge, he shall not break his word. He shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.

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Leviticus 19:11-12

You shall not steal; you shall not deal falsely; you shall not lie to one another. You shall not swear by my name falsely, and so profane the name of your God:

I am the LORD.

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Deuteronomy 30:19b-20

Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live, loving the LORD your God, obeying His voice and holding fast to Him, for He is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

- 16 "Woe to you, blind guides, who say,

 'If anyone swears by the temple, it is nothing, but if anyone swears by
 the gold of the temple, he is bound by his oath.'
- You blind fools! For which is greater, the gold or the temple that has made the gold sacred?
- And you say, 'If anyone swears by the altar, it is nothing, but if anyone swears by the gift that is on the altar, he is bound by his oath.'
- You blind men! For which is greater, the gift or the altar that makes the gift sacred?
- So whoever swears by the altar swears by it and by everything on it.
- And whoever swears by the temple swears by it and by Him who dwells in it.
- And whoever swears by heaven swears by the throne of God and by Him who sits upon it.

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Psalm 15
